PROGRAM 2009

1. SHORT PROGRAM: 1,5 – 2 h; N\$ 120.- / person

You will get an introduction into our traditional life and you will learn a bit about our historic craftsmanship. Follow us on a short bushwalk and enjoy the singing and dancing afterwards.

2. SPEND A DAY WITH US: 4 – 5 h; N\$ 250.- / person

Experience the daily routine in our traditional life by joining us for a whole day. Try to make fire, stamp the mahangu and taste our traditional food. You will learn about some of our traditional craftsmanship (weaving, forging an arrow point, making jewellery, bows, arrows, spears etc.). Follow us on a bushwalk and get an impression about how we used to hunt and fish. Enjoy the evening around our camp fire with singing, dancing and games.

3. OUR PRESENT VILLAGE: 1,5 – 2 h; N\$ 75.- / person

Meet our friendly people on a guided walk through our village and see how we live today.

4. EXTRAS

Film making: Professional filming for documentaries, movies etc
2 Days unlimited filming: N\$ 4500.-
For every further day: N\$ 1500.-

Craft shop: Feel free to visit our craft shop. We only sell traditional crafts that we make our self.

Camping: Camping in our bushcamp (no water, no electricity)
N\$ 30.- / person / night.
(At the moment we are busy to build up a proper campsite)

Fire wood: N\$ 10.- / bundle
